
Staff are virtually powerless to prevent the theft and are often told not to confront or pursue shoplifters — allowing them to nab thousands of dollars worth of goods with little effort.

Smokeshield, who specialise in security resources for businesses across Melbourne, are launching the AI camera systems — dubbed 'Dragonfruit AI' — into Australia.

Creators trained the AI technology on thousands of hours of standard CCTV footage to decipher the differences between the normal and suspicious behaviours of shoppers.
